## **Numbers to consider in making your pledge:**

Of the over all \$130,000 we want to raise in this Capital Campaign, we need pledges from everyone to total in the range of \$60,000.

$60,000 / 5 \text{ years} = \$12,000$  a year we need to raise.

$12,000 / 30 \text{ families} = \$400$  a year per family for 5 years.

$400 / 2 = \$200$  every 6 months for 5 years

$400 / 4 = \$100$  every 3 months (quarterly) for 5 years

$400 / 12 = \$34$  every month for 5 years

$400 / 52 = \$8$  every week for 5 years.

We understand that not everyone can afford \$400 a year.

We also understand that some can afford more than \$400 a year.

What is important here is this. We love God and we thank Him for bringing us together in this community. We thank Him for the opportunity to celebrate the Traditional Latin Mass. And we thank Him for this opportunity to get our own place so that we may better worship Him and glorify Him. By wanting this place, we are saying that we believe that this space will help us in our desire to become holy. And that is what this is all about, GET HOLY !!!

With this in mind, I ask you to honestly and humbly pray with God, talk with your spouse and even your children about sacrifices that may have to be made for 5 years (not too long) so that something good for us can come about.

Then from your heart, as an act of love, worship and sacrifice make your pledge of what you feel God is asking of you.
