Exorcism of the New Church

The Church of the Brethren have officially moved out of the church and we are not free to take full possession of it.

The rest of the rules are these:

- Please fast and pray all morning and afternoon till about 1 pm. Medicine and water only. If you need to, a very light meal may be acceptable. After 1 pm all may feel free to eat as usual.
- Do not pray that the demons be case out. This is the function of the official Rite of Exorcism. If you try to do this with your prayers, you could put yourself in spiritual harms way. Like at Mass, trust the Rite to do the job. Your job is to pray for our safety as we perform the exorcism and for all that is good for the community: our success, growth, purity, holiness, the remodeling, special needs of individuals and families in the parish and other such things. Keep your prayers positive and hopeful, filled with joy and love and trust in God's divine providence.
- You may do this at home or you can come to the Cathedral for Mass at 9 am and adoration. We will need a few people at least to volunteer to be there for the entire time of the exorcism or to be there in shifts. It may take 3,4,6,8 hours. We will not know until we begin the exorcism.

The date of the exorcism will be September 7th. This is a First Saturday and we will begin everything at 9 am with Mass as usual. Adoration will begin after Mass and the exorcism will begin when my assistants and I arrive at the church.
