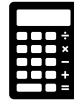

## Please Observe the Following

In order to keep people safe we need to do the following:

1. Do not come to church if your immunity is down or are susceptible to getting sick.
2. Do not come to church if you are sick or not feeling well.
3. Do not come to church if you have been exposed to the virus.
4. Wait the appropriate incubation time (14 days) to make sure you are not sick before returning to church.
5. No unnecessary touch.
6. Sneezing can happen for several reasons. I sneeze due to allergies quite often. In any case, sneezing in public needs to be done appropriately. Sneeze in a downward direction between your elbow and body. Then remember that you are contaminated. Take appropriate precautions to wash up and not touch or let other touch your clothing where you sneezed.
7. Blowing of nose. If you blow your nose, please dispose of tissue in the garbage and wash your hands.
8. I will not greet people to limit contact.
9. If you become sick, please let me know so we can let others know. If you know of any particular exposers, please let them know directly and quickly.
