We now have internet, so we are now able to use a kiosk to take donations.

I will place the kiosk in the back of church on the table for those who choose to use it.

For those who do not know what a kiosk is, it is basically a dedicated iPad with a program running on it that allows you to make donations with your credit card. It is self serve, but I can help you if you need it.

What makes it a kiosk rather than just an iPad, is the fact that the software is locked so you can not do anything else with the iPad.

Generally a kiosk would be locked down so no one can steel it, but that would cost more money. The iPad we are using is a very old one that I do not use any more. It will still work for our purpose here. When we do get the stand for it to lock it down, it will come with a card reader so you do not have to type the card number in yourself.
