This report covers the Fiscal year 2020 (July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020)

This is the year that we bought our church and did all our construction. We had a good year over all, financially speaking. I feel very secure moving us into the future, that we will be able to meet all our financial obligations.

Assets:

We started with \$ 251,018 and finished with \$ 198,839.

Net loss of \$ 52,179.

Liabilities:

We owe the bishop about \$35,000 (estimated)
other than this, we have maintained our goal of no debt.

I rounded all the above numbers. Actual expense is \$204,377.57

Note that remodeling took a lot out of us. Those expenses are a lot less this year (Fiscal year 2021) as we are only doing gradual remodeling now as funds, time, talent, resources and opportunity present themselves.

Remember that our goal is to become financially self sustaining. In 3 years, the bishop will stop subsidizing us and we will sink or swim. Our current financial situation is much better now with the addition of many families to our community. I believe we will indeed make our self sustaining goal a reality. Self sustaining with current budget requires \$2,200 a week income. I suspect this number will go up over time.
