40 Days for life

40 Days for life begins Wednesday, February 17 and goes to March 28.

The goal is to get people outside the Planned Parenthood at Frandor 7 days a week from 7am through 7pm, but we are <u>especially</u> focused on the weekdays when they are open!

We are asking people to volunteer one hour every week for the duration of the vigil to stand and pray outside the abortion (murder) clinic. Many simply pray the 15 decades of the rosary, but you may pray other prayers or any prayer you like.
