Fr. Robideau – What will he say this time?  
I can't wait !

I had a great time yesterday at the conference. It has been a while since I gave one and I always really enjoy them. I hope you did too. Thank you to all of you who attended in person and who listened on Facebook.

Did you see this one? Rep. Jerry Nadler of the pagan, baby killing democratic party had something very interesting to say. After a Republican (not much better than a democrat) said that God creates men and women either as a man or as a woman, Nadler confirmed that he chooses hell for his eternal destination (at least at this point in his life). He said, "What any religious tradition describes as God's will, is no concern of this congress."

Marry is Queen of Heaven and earth, Oops, Hillary is upset now. OH, fecal matter! I used gender specific "King" and "Queen." Now the trans-perverted people are upset with me. allowed to matter. – YOU SEE – everything can be made to be political. We cannot allow them to control us and to silence us.

Now think about what Nadler said. "...God's will, is no concern of this congress." They take the high road that is neutral and above all bias and political rhetoric. They do not take religious sides or any side but that which is "the right thing to do."

But let me ask this now... Like above where we see that there is nothing religious that is not political, can it not be said that there is nothing political that is not religious?

Religion is a system of beliefs that define how a person may or may not live their life. This means that atheism is a belief about God. They believe that God does not exist. Agnostics do not care if God exists. Human Secularists believe that the collective mankind is God and the determiner of all that is good or evil and of what is truth. Pantheists believe that everything is God, so "use the force Luke."

Any system of thought that guides a person's meaning of life; that determines what is good and evil; that judges what is right and wrong, that system is by its very nature religious.

So, Mr. Nadler, if religion is to be kept out of Congress and it can be shown that all politics are religious, what is left to be discussed?

Your real point is that only your views, opinions and agendas can be discussed. Everyone else be damned!

What you really mean is that we cannot force our religion on others, but it is fine that you force your "religion" on us. To put it in other words, "My will, not yours be done." You do not get much more anti-christ than that.

As Catholics, where do we go from here? We know that Nadler is not the exception, but the norm. Their agenda is the "Great Reset." If you have not heard about it, I implore you to research it. The basic gist is that they want to use this man made crisis or any crisis to create fear in the hearts and minds of people so as to control and manipulate them. It is about gaining power over people.

With this power, they then want to change everything in the world. And when I say they want to change it, I mean that they want to change it for their benefit. They will do well in the Great Reset and the rest of us, -- well -- not so much. We will have the pleasure of paying for it all, if you like that sort of thing.

As Catholics, again, where do we go from here?

We must be vigilant and remember that we are not called to follow culture; we are to generate culture. If we do not, they will and that is exactly what they are doing. Do we want the kind of culture they are building? Do we want to be a part of their humanistic religion? Do we want to be silenced?

Glen Beck had an interesting line the other day. He said the three "S"es. Not shoot, shovel and shut up, but suggest, shove and shoot. Fascist will first suggest you do or believe in a certain way. They will then shove you a little and then a lot to get you to do or believe in that way. If you still persist in a non-conformist manner, they shoot you.

We must act! We must resist! We must act in a way that frustrates them. Remember what I wrote a few weeks ago. The "They" act in such a way so as to make us uncomfortable. They keep applying their methods so as to keep increasing our discomfort with the hope that we get wore down and give in. This is the shoving I am talking about. They are shoving us. We need to turn the table and not play in their playground, but to apply our methods to make them uncomfortable so that they leave us alone and stop persecuting us. They can believe what they want, they just cannot be allowed to force us to believe with them or to be allowed to stele our hard earned dollars to pay for their evil.

This is Catholic. "Faith without works is dead." "The lukewarm I will spew out." We are called to act in this world with passion to build the Kingdom of God. We have His marching orders and we need not wait for the bishops or anyone else to get on board. We just need to be on board.
